

# PLACE BASED COMMUNITY GROUPS - PRESENTATION TO THE CIVIC AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

#### **BACKGROUND**

- The Civic Affairs Committee is delegated to decide on Activities of Place Based Community Groups (PBCGs) as detailed in the Council's Committee Structures and Delegations Manual (2023, P. 13).
- The Civic Affairs Committee has invited PBCGs to present to them, so they are updated on the range of activities and services that they deliver in their local communities.
- This report provides a summary of the two PBCGs who will present to the Civic Affairs Committee at the 5 November meeting, namely:
  - Strath Taieri Connect Charitable Trust
  - BIAS Charitable Trust

### **DISCUSSION**

Strath Taieri Connect Charitable Trust

The Strath Taieri Connect Charitable Trust (Trust) is a registered charity that is governed by 6 trustees; Lynnore Templeton (Chair), Emily Jones (Treasurer), Robin Thomas, Carmon Hope, Barry Taylor and Bridget Roulston (Trustees). The Strath Taieri community is rural,



approximately 80 kilometres (75 minutes) drive from Dunedin's CBD servicing over 700 people and families.

- 7 The Trust employs one part-time Coordinator (Rebecca Costelloe), and two part-time Assistants (Dianna Bradshaw and Emma O'Meara, and a part-time Digital Support person (Jacquie Lucas).
- 8 The group's purpose is proudly displayed on their website as:

To enhance community wellbeing through CONNECTION, ENGAGEMENT and GROWING COMPETENCY —

Whakapiki i te Oranga Hapori mā te Whakawhanaungatanga, te Whakangungu, me te Whakapakari Āheinga.

- Their core values are Inclusiveness, Building Resilience and Fairness Whakaruia, Whakapakari and Tika. The Trust is currently updating their strategic plan but remain focussed on their short-medium plan. One of the key areas that they lead on is collaborating with their local and rural communities and finding grants to support local projects.
- The Trust runs a busy events calendar offering community events, training and courses for the whole community. Examples from the past month are shown below:



The Trust also works with other local groups such as being the umbrella group for the community garden – Grow Cotts and working alongside the Strath Taieri Food Fairies a local group who offers food support. The Trust also writes a monthly column in the local newsletter – Rock and Pillar Post.

#### Brockville (BIAS)

- The BIAS Charitable Trust is a registered charitable trust based in the Brockville Community in Dunedin/ Ōtepoti area. BIAS acts as an umbrella for smaller initiatives within their local community ensuring a whole-of-community approach to improving social, economic, cultural, and environmental well-being. The Chair is Hughan Gould and they employ 1 full time place-based manager Irene Harris.
- BIAS is deeply rooted in their geographical community they serve in promoting a strong understanding of its needs and aspirations. BIAS values community input and involvement and ensures the community's active participation in the development and delivery of their projects.



- 14 BIAS operates a community hub (Brockville Community Connect) which is based at the Brockville shopping centre. It is open Tuesday through to Thursday and is a bustling and inclusive space for community members to come together, make connections, find resources and engage with community activities and projects.
- The hub is also the home of BIAS' community food bank in collaboration with Kiwi Harvest which coordinates food parcels for community members in need. They also operate several Pātaka Kai/Food Pantries throughout the community.
- BIAS also coordinates several community events such as; Pūaka/Matariki celebrations; Community workshops; Community hangi; Neighbours Day event in collaboration with Kaianga Ora; and Community Law workshops on topics that impact their community such as employment, tenancy law and much more.
- 17 BIAS also offer services such as interpreting support, and works alongside other agencies such as The Department of Corrections.
- 18 The Brockville Community is one of the more culturally diverse and high needs communities within the Dunedin City Boundary. BIAS works hard to ensure its community has a voice by advocating for their needs to both local and central government institutions.

Staff have engaged with all of the PBCG applicants to ensure that their information is correct for the Grants Subcommittee and to understand the future aspirations of each PBCG.

#### **DISCUSSION**

**Council and Committee meetings** 


From May 2024 until the end of October 2024, Council held 11 meetings over 17 days considering more than 105 reports. During the period, 11 committees and subcommittees held a total of 34 meetings. During these meetings 50 individuals and groups in public forum spoke on a variety of topics. Community boards and Place-based groups also briefed the Civic Affairs Committee on their activities.



#### **Engagement and Hearings**

- 5 Council is required to consult with the public in a variety of ways, formally and informally.
- The following graph tracks the number of submissions received on the recent 10 Year Plan and Annual Plans.

- 7 Council and various hearings panels also provide a mechanism for people to present their views in public. Three hearings on parking changes and the Dog Control Bylaw, have been held since July.
- 8 Council also conducts hearings and decision-making meetings for several regulatory functions such as the District Licensing and Resource Management. The District Licensing committee held 30 separate meetings, some over multiple days and there were seven hearings held under the Resource Management Act.

# **Council Workshops**

9 30 workshops have been held on a variety of topics. Since mid-November 2023 Council has been giving notice of workshop topics to be held. Information is provided on the Council's website.


#### **Community Boards**

As part of the governance structure of Council, the community boards provide both an advocacy and decision-making function. The boards have connections with a variety of community groups in each of their board's area. Since July the community boards heard from over 26 groups or individuals. Each community board is invited to brief the Civic Affairs Committee on matters of note in each Board's area.



Requests under the Local Government and Official Information Meetings Act (LGOIMAs)

Council is required to respond to requests for information under the Local Government Official 11 information and meetings Act 1987. The following graph tracks the numbers of LGOIMAs processed and answered for the last 3 years.



- 12 Since 2020 staff have reviewed processes for responding to LGOIMAs and provided training and guidance across the organisation to assist in improving the response time. This has also included a checklist which is completed for each LGOIMA. We continue to review our processes.
- 13 Three complaints to the Ombudsman have been received since May 2024.
